

DEVELOPMENTAL COORDINATION DISORDER

Have you ever been worried about your child's coordination and ability to perform simple motor tasks? Is your child clumsy and having difficulty learning new motor skills?

Children with Developmental Coordination Disorder (DCD) have these characteristics. It can affect their fine motor skills or gross motor skills or both.

DCD can occur on it's own or be associated with other developmental problems.
